## What are reviews?

A review is a summary, analysis and evaluation of a text resulting in an opinion or judgement. Reviews aim to summarise/analyse a text and access its appeal and value to its audience. Reviews can include factual information as well as opinion.

## Monday Structure of Writing A Review reviews Title Introduction A review includes: Context and background information— this includes State information a title, author/artists/composer and a brief about the text summary of the particular topic, issue or thing. Brief Summary Text description— this includes an analysis of Summarise the main significant features such as character(s) settings, points/events descriptions, themes, graphics, actors, genre, Critical Summary producers etc. Detailed assessment of Conclusion— this concludes an evaluation of the the different elements text and gives a recommendation that attempts to persuade the audience to do something.
